

Re: Ordinance 2026-05 Creating FY26 Budget Amendment 5, to increase available funds for the Elementary School Playground Replacement Project in FY26 by \$2,600,000

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**SUMMARY:** Ordinance 2026-05 requests the early appropriation of \$2,600,000 in project funding from FY27 to FY26 to enable procurement of playground equipment and allow the City to enter into contracts for site work and installation.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** This was placed on the CMMP in FY25 and council approved \$200,000 for design in FY26. Additionally, \$2,600,000 was estimated to be the project costs for the replacement of the playground and field in FY27.

**BACKGROUND:** The playground at Eagle's View Elementary School was constructed in 2002. While the equipment has served the Unalaska community well, it has reached the end of its useful life and should be replaced to ensure continued safe use.

In FY24, the Department of Parks, Culture & Recreation (PCR) completed a master plan for the park area, which identified several deficiencies, including:

- Safety concerns related to open fall hazards from removed or aging components; and
- Poor field conditions, including clumpy surfaces and lack of a discernible drainage system.

Within the master plan assessment, the playground equipment received a rating of 2 (meets expectations but at or near end of life), while the field surface received a rating of 1 (does not meet expectations). Recommendations included increasing the variety of play elements and improving the field surface to create a destination playground and better serve users.

Community input strongly supported replacement of this playground. At a public intercept conducted during PCR's Spring Festival, 134 community members were contacted, and a new playground at Eagle's View Elementary School was identified as the top priority. Additionally, only 27% of respondents to the master plan community survey indicated that the playground fully met their needs.

PCR and Unalaska City School District (UCSD) staff have worked with Great Western Recreation over the past year to develop a replacement playground design that will serve students and the broader community for many years.

Although Council approved \$200,000 in FY26 for engineering and design, Great Western Recreation has provided the playground design at no cost, substantially reducing project planning expenses.

Great Western Recreation is also able to supply the playground equipment and install the field surface through OMNIA cooperative purchasing partners, ensuring competitive pricing. OMNIA Partners is a national cooperative purchasing organization that meets the sole sourcing requirements in the city's purchasing policy section H.i.4, "A provider of supplies or services is providing another Alaska municipality, the State of Alaska, or the United States, with supplies or services following a competitive pricing procedure and the city contract is on substantially the same terms as those obtained by the other governmental entity's competitive pricing procedure."

OMNIA pricing is available on the playground equipment, field surfacing and field installation, and these would be purchased through sole source agreement from Great Western Recreation. OMNIA pricing is current to 2026 and would likely increase if the purchase of equipment was delayed to 2027.

While some work is still being done to finalize the quote with Great Western Recreation, the total for the playground equipment, field surfacing, freight, and installation of the field surfacing should be around \$1,400,000. The remaining \$200,000 of existing funding and \$1,200,000 of this newly appropriated funding will be used for the remaining project items including: disposal of the old playground equipment, preparation of the playground and field areas, and installation of the playground equipment. These totals are in line with the original project estimated costs of \$2,800,000.

City maintenance staff will remove and dispose of the existing playground equipment; this assistance will help to save costs that would have been associated with an outside contractor performing this work.

Upon approval of the budget amendment, PCR will place the order via sole source agreement for the playground equipment and field surfacing and issue an RFP for contract services to:

- Prepare the existing playground area;
- Install the replacement playground equipment; and
- Prepare existing field for installation of turf surfacing.

Routine maintenance is provided for the playground facilities by UCSD. The City has been asked to assist with project completion. This funding partnership follows the same structure previously used for the UCSD High School Park Replacement.

Pursuant to City Code § [2.98.090\(b\)](#), routine maintenance for the life of this playground facility has been provided by school staff however, code also outlines the responsibility for the city to provide for major rehabilitation, construction, and repair: "The City Council, through the City Manager, shall provide for all major rehabilitation, all construction, and major repair of school buildings."

**DISCUSSION:** Funding for construction is currently planned for FY27; however, staff believes it is critical that the project be completed in Summer 2026 before the start of the school year.

Great Western Recreation requires approximately 12 weeks to manufacture the equipment and an additional 4 weeks for shipping to Unalaska. This 16-week lead time means that ordering cannot realistically wait until the start of FY27 on July 1, 2026.

If the City delays ordering until July 2026, the playground would not be installed and ready for use by the start of the 2026–27 school year. UCSD staff have indicated that if the playground cannot be substantially complete before school begins, they would prefer to postpone construction until the following summer. This would require continued use of aging equipment that has reached end of life and may present increasing safety concerns.

Approving this amendment allows staff to proceed with procurement and scheduling in time to ensure a functional playground is available for students in Fall 2026.

**ALTERNATIVES:** Council may leave the funding in FY27, which would delay the project until Summer 2027 and may result in:

- Increased equipment and labor costs;
- Continued safety risks from aging equipment; and
- Ongoing poor field conditions.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** This budget amendment allocates \$2,600,000 from the general fund for FY26 to the Elementary School Playground Replacement Project [SS26A].

**LEGAL:** If the existing playground were inspected by a certified playground safety inspector, there is a high probability that portions of the playground could be required to close until replaced or significantly repaired.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends approval of Ordinance 2026-05.

**PROPOSED MOTION:** 1<sup>st</sup> Reading: I move to introduce Ordinance 2026-05 and schedule it for second reading and public hearing on February 24, 2026.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: I move to adopt Ordinance 2026-05.

**CITY MANAGER COMMENTS:** I appreciate the work PCR and UCSD have done to bring this project to a point where Council can make a timely decision. The need to replace the Eagle's View playground has been well-documented through the master planning process, community input, and the condition assessments completed over the past two years.

Advancing the funding into FY26 is primarily a scheduling and safety issue. The manufacturing and shipping lead times mean that waiting until July would push construction into the school year, which UCSD has indicated is not feasible. Approving this amendment now allows the City to secure 2026 OMNIA pricing, avoid cost escalation, and ensure the playground is completed before students return in the fall.

The partnership model with UCSD mirrors the approach previously used for the High School Park project, and the use of City maintenance staff for demolition reduces overall project costs. The total project budget remains consistent with the original estimate.

For these reasons, I support staff's recommendation.

### INSTALLATION CONDITIONS:

- **ACCESS:** Site should be clear, level and allow for unrestricted access of trucks and machinery.
- **STORAGE:** Customer is responsible for providing a secure location to off-load and store the equipment during the installation process. Once equipment has delivered to the site, the owner is responsible should theft or vandalism occur unless other arrangements are made and noted on the quotation.
